Pathways board members cannot profit from Pathways activities. Andrea Dewey only mentioned that she was the real estate agent and she would make 3% of the sale price after David Craig asked her if she would make money from this sale. 3% of \$2,400,000 is \$72,000. Pam Uher said this conflict of interest "can be worked around".

All board members should have been notified of this interest in this property before this meeting.

Big step for Pathways.

Lots of details are needed first.

Non-profits don't have money for their normal operations, will not have money for leasing property from this ranch.


