inspection/upgrade. Use as a multi-use facility (e.g. shelter, education).

May be possible to obtain state/county funding for this if can also be used by the state/county. County currently contracts with Watermelon Ranch (Rio Rancho NM -- www.wmranch.org). Sanctuary at Traditions may provide county with another animal facility.

Need good business plan, cheap lawyer to handle the real estate sale details.

Plan big here -- include vet services (on site and contract), spay/neuter services, vet transport bus (mention in **business plan**).

Will check with Rio Rancho mayor (Tom Swisstack) to see if this town could benefit from an animal sanctuary at Traditions. Said she knows him from work.

Once have a good business plan, can contact others for partnership possibility. Sandoval County may be a good partner.
